1) DEVELOPMENT AND PEACE -

CARITAS CANADA: Thousands of Development and Peace - Caritas Canada members across the country form a network of people committed to social justice. Through education, action and fundraising campaigns, they learn about global issues and work to transform our world. Last Sunday at St. Pius X hall we launched our Fall Education Campaign. We have been asked by our partner ERIC - Progreso to raise awareness of the tragic plight of the communities of Guapinol and the San Pedro sector in Honduras. An open - pit iron mine has polluted their rivers and they have been trying in vain to shut it down. After 88 days of peaceful demonstrations in fighting for their rights they have been threatened, criminalized, imprisoned and killed. We are asked to sign a letter to the Honduran ambassador to Canada. Our signatures will add weight to this letter, which presses the Honduran Government to better protect all Honduran human rights and environmental

defenders and to cancel all irregularly granted mining permits. You are encouraged to sign the letter on line or after all masses this weekend. Learn more at devp.org/campaign.
