New Pilgrim Path Website of the Week: Ignatian Spiritual Exercises in Ordinary Life


Experience a relationship with God coming alive in the midst of everyday life. Discover a freedom and peace too often out of reach in the modern world. The potentially transformative Spiritual Exercises are a compilation of meditations, prayers, and contemplative practices developed by St. Ignatius Loyola to help people deepen their relationship with God. For centuries, the Exercises were most commonly given as a “long retreat” of about 30 days in solitude and silence. In recent years, there has been a renewed emphasis on the Spiritual Exercises as a program for lay people. Many people now opt to pursue the programme online. You will need to commit to at least an hour a day for nine months to prayer and meditation (guidelines for each day are provided). There is no charge. Find out more at: www.newpilgrimpath.ie.
