Last year marked the 1,700th anniversary of the Council of Nicaea which first formulated the beautiful, illuminating words of what came to be known as the Nicene Creed, common to many Christian denominations across the world. In introducing the Creed, the Anglican poet/priest, Malcolm Guite says: “The Nicene Creed has summarised, expressed, and opened out the heart of our shared Christian faith for 17 centuries! Almost nothing else in our culture and heritage has lasted that long. This creed has persisted through wars and revolutions, through changes of dynasty, the birth and development of languages, the rise and fall of empires. It has even survived the tragic divisions of Christendom.
