#### Queen Charlotte THEATRE CLUB PERFORMANCE:

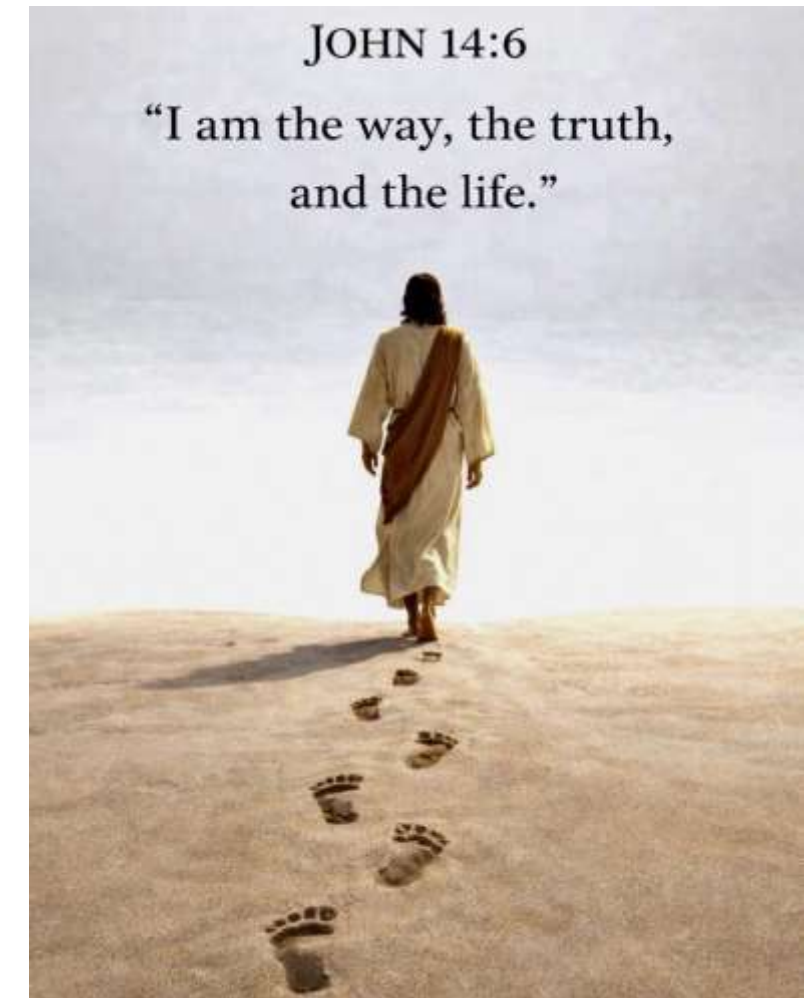
