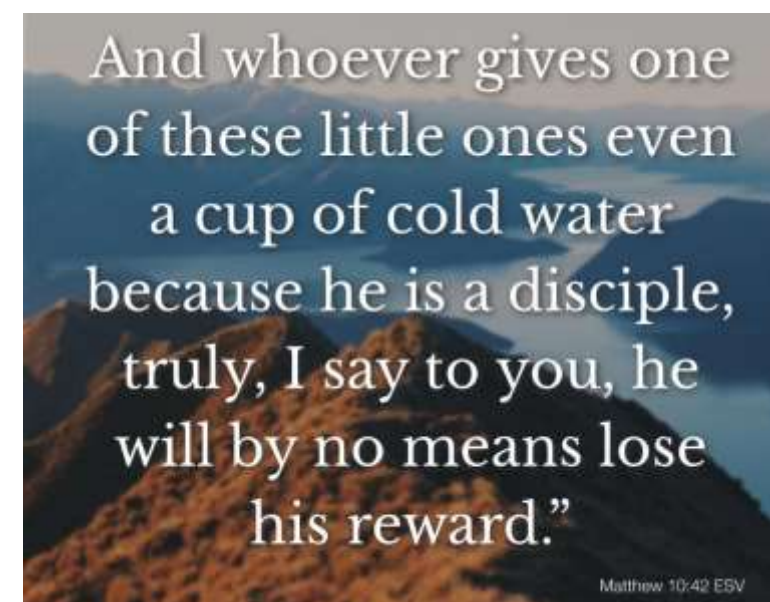

Progressive Organ Concert Sunday June 28 in Charlottetown 1:30, 2:30 and 3:30 p.m- Sample three wonderful pipe organ recitals while strolling the streets of Charlottetown. The fun starts at St. Paul’s Anglican Church (Prince Street) at 1:30 p.m. Proceed to Trinity United Church (also on Prince Street) for a 2:30 p.m. concert and conclude the afternoon at St. Dunstan’s Basilica (Great George Street) at 3:30 p.m. Each 30-minute concert features organists from across PEI performing on three magnificent instruments in three beautiful churches. Admission is by donation, which supports the Dr. Alan Reesor Memorial Scholarship Fund, which finances young musicians taking up the instrument by offering them free introductory lessons.
