Holy Redeemer Church invites our entire community to our Family Fun Day on **Sunday, August 9th, starting at 12:00 PM.**

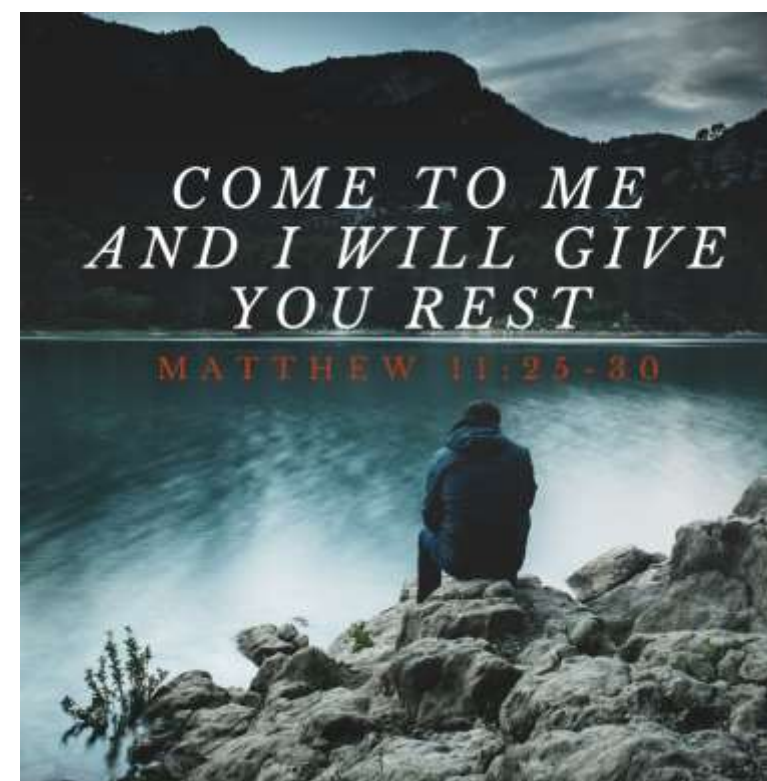
Bring your family, invite your friends, and come enjoy a wonderful afternoon together. All are welcome!
