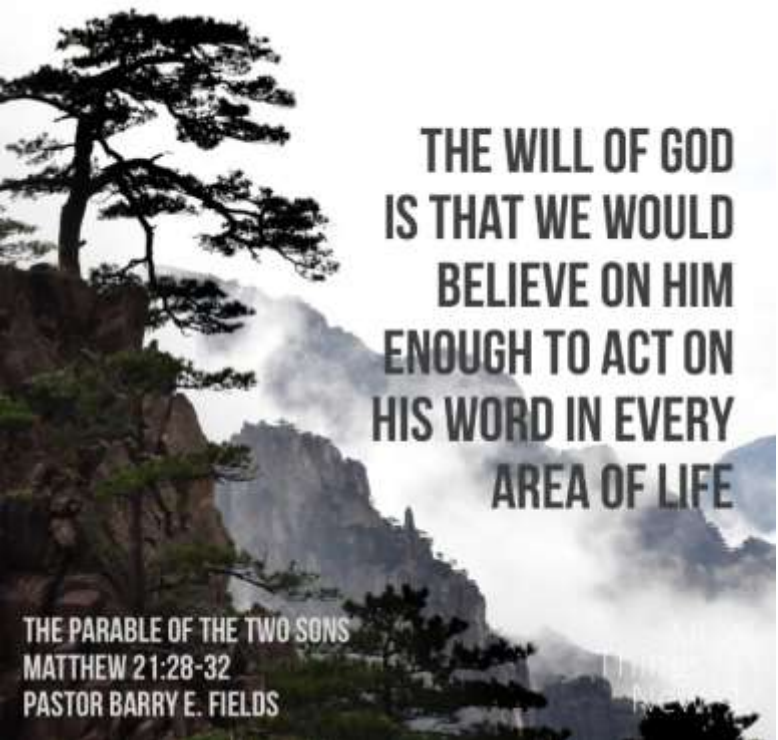

The Season of Creation is an annual Christian celebration during which the ecumenical family around the world unites to reflect and care for Mother Earth, our common home. The Season of Creation begins on September 1st, the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation (established by Pope Francis in 2015), and ends on October 4th, the Feast of St. Francis of Assisi, the patron saint of ecology. This year, the Season of Creation will be marked in our Diocese on Tuesday, September 29, 2026 during the noonday mass at **St. Francis of Assisi Church in Cornwall**, PE. During this celebration, Fr. Pierre Ducharme, OFM will speak on the need to renew our relationship with our Creator and all of creation. Fr. Pierre is a Franciscan Friar who currently serves as Minister Provincial of the OFM Franciscans of Canada.
